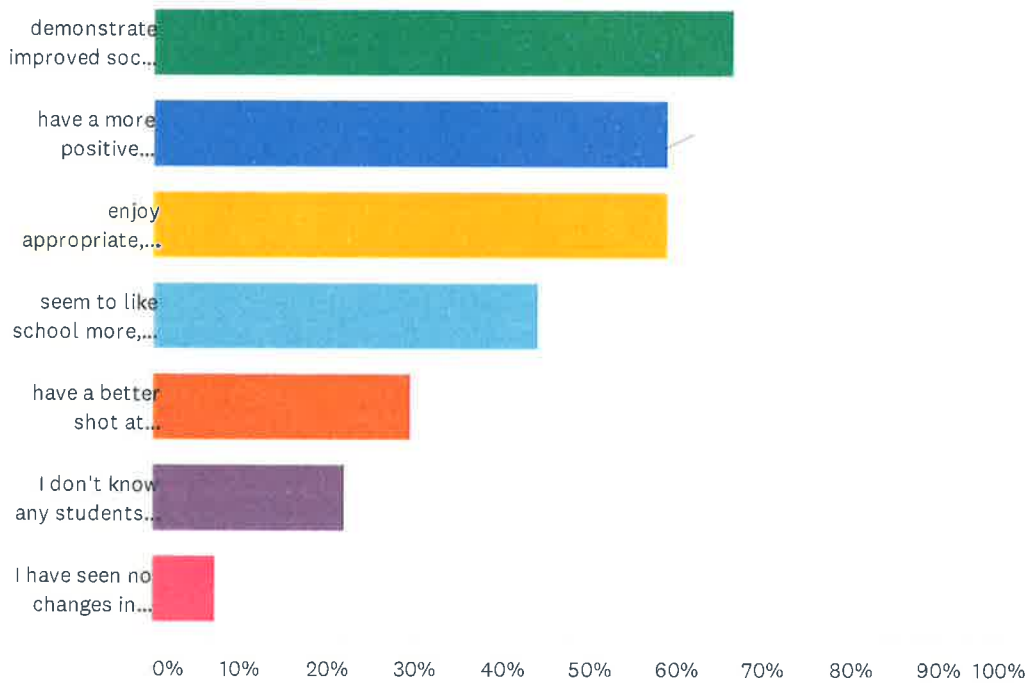


Q1 "Since being matched with a mentor, the students I know..." (check all that apply)

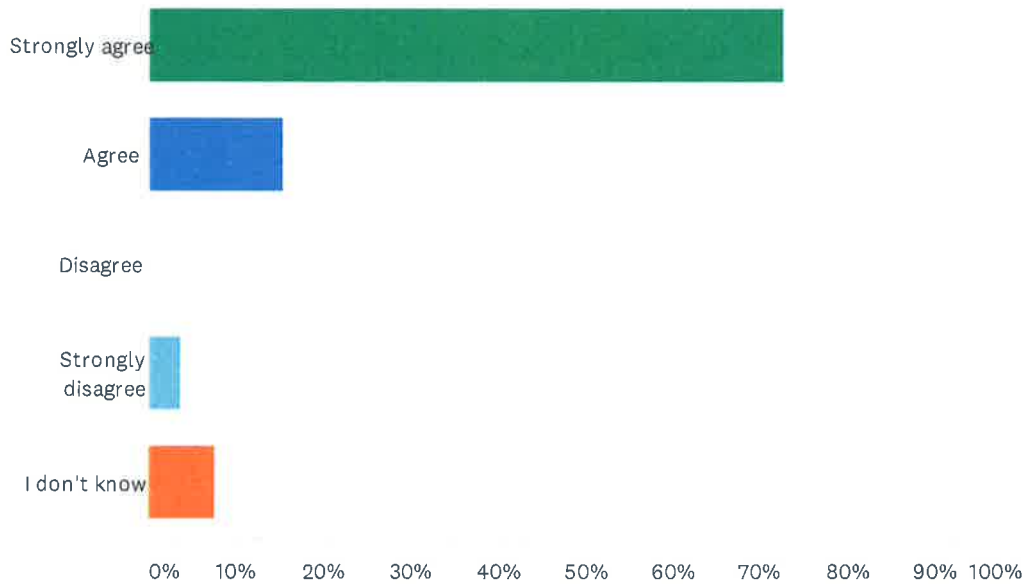

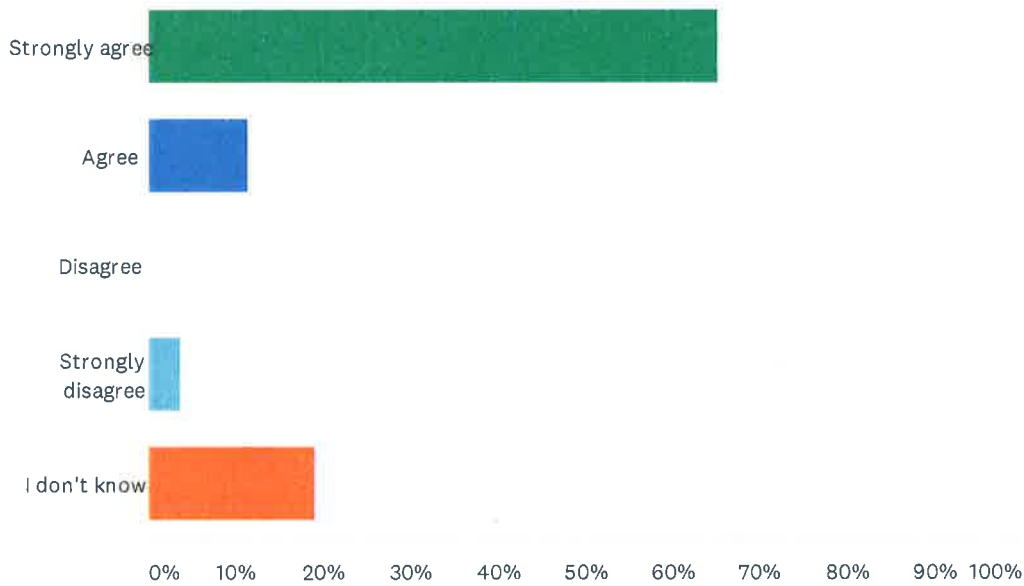

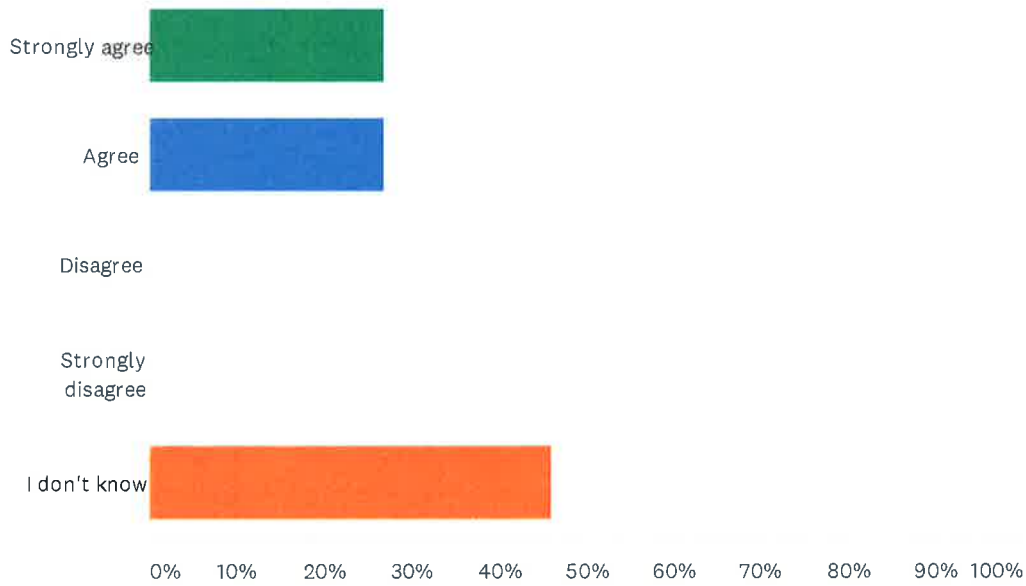

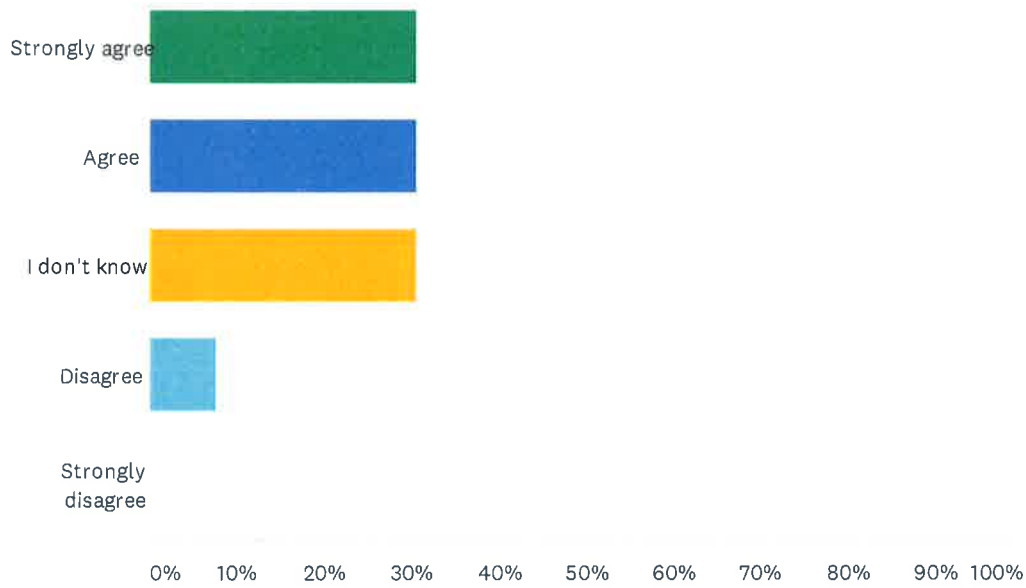

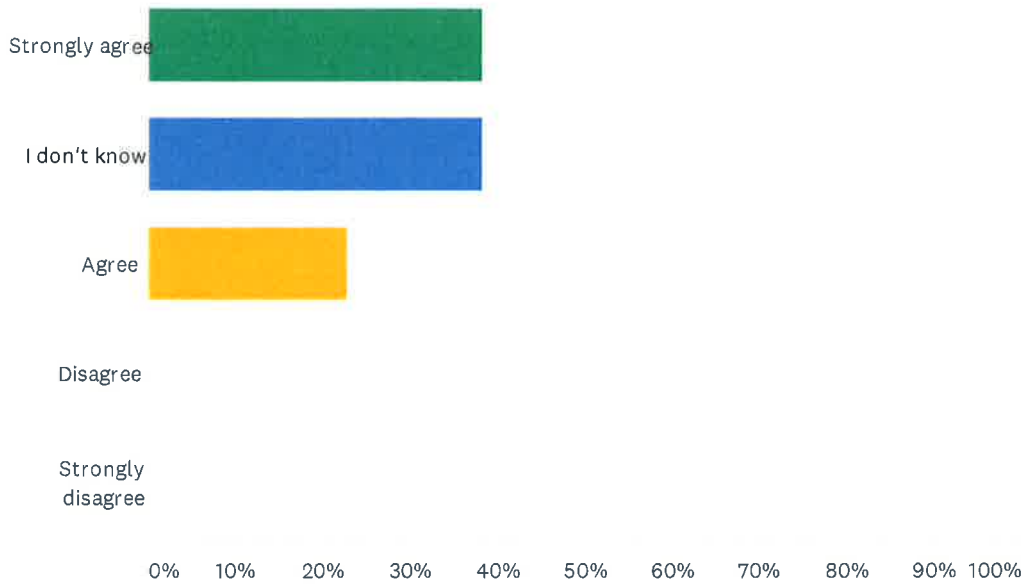
